STRAWBERRY CAKE

INGREDIENTS:

- White cake mix
- 3 Tbsp. flour
- 3 oz. Strawberry Jello mix
- 1/2 cup strawberries
- 4 eggs room temp
- 1/2 cup water
- 3/4 cup salad oil

INSTRUCTIONS:

- In a mixing bowl, empty cake mix, flour, and Jello mix. Mix well.
- Add ingredients in order given and mix well.
- Bake at 350 degrees in 9x13 pan 40-45 minutes.

ICING:

- 1 box powdered sugar
- 1/2 cup strawberries
- 1 stick margarine room temp
- Mix and blend until smooth. Apply icing after cake is cooled.

NOTES: You can smash or puree strawberries if you wish.
This cake gets better the longer it sits!



CREAMY BLUEBERRY GELATIN SALAD

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 pkg. (3 oz.) each grape gelatin
- 2 cups boiling water
- 1 can (21 oz.) blueberry pie filling
- 1 can (20 oz.) unsweetened crushed pineapple, undrained

Topping:

- 1 pkg. (8 oz.) cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup (8 oz.) sour cream
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup chopped walnuts

INSTRUCTIONS:

- In a large bowl, dissolve gelatin in boiling water. Cool for 10 minutes. Stir in pie filling and pineapple until blended. Transfer to a 13x9-inch dish. Cover and refrigerate until partially set, about 1 hour.
- For topping, in a small bowl, combine the cream cheese, sour cream, sugar, and vanilla. Carefully spread over gelatin; sprinkle with walnuts. Cover and refrigerate until firm.

Community Service Opportunity


