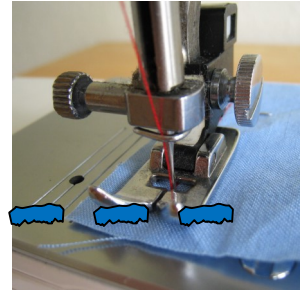

Log Cabin Quilts!

Part I—February Class

You do not need to bring a sewing machine or supplies.

You will need paper and pencil for taking notes.

Please bring color pencils if you have them for visual design layout purposes.

You will receive your Log Cabin book. ~ \$5

We will demonstrate how to utilize the book for choosing which log cabin design you wish to make. You will choose what size quilt you want to make. We will show you how to plan for fabric needs and selections based on your choices.

We will demonstrate how and what tool options you have for cutting fabric strips.

You do not need to purchase the log cabin template cutting ruler. We will have a couple in class for you to use and we will show you other options and ways to cut your fabric without the ruler that pairs with the Log Cabin book. However, if you'd like a ruler they will be \$12 (that is the wholesale price, regular price is around \$24).

You can let us know ahead of time if you'd like a ruler or you can let us know the day of the February class. We will not need to utilize the ruler until March class.

Part II ~ March Class

You will need to bring your Log Cabin book, your fabric strips, sewing machine and sewing supplies.

We will be cutting our fabric strips into needed sizes and assembling our blocks.

As always, if this class does not interest you please feel free to bring a UFO or some other project to work on and enjoy the day of fun & fellowship with us.
