

crust

Directions

Dissolve Jello in boiling water.

Whisk in yogurt & frozen whipped topping until smooth.

Pour mixture into prepared pie crust.

Chill in refrigerator for 3 hours or until firm.

Serve with strawberry pie glaze drizzled over top.

Garnish with sliced strawberry halves


