## In-Stitches Quilt Class July 18, 2025 @ 10 a.m. Seasonal Placemats

These fun and easy to make placemats will have you all set for the year! Cute seasonal designs! Easy beginner machine applique and basic sewing techniques make this a quick fun project. You will receive patterns for all four designs. You will only make one in class.

Fabric Requirements: 1 fat quarter for background behind applique 12 - 2 ½ inch squares for patch work 1 - 6 ½ inch X 16 inch rectangle for pocket 1 fat quarter for backing (includes enough for binding) Various scraps for applique (Larger scrap pieces for snowman & pumpkin) 1 - fat quarter size batting (Pellon plus recommended) 1 - fat quarter size fusible interfacing (will be provided in class for one placemat)

Supplies needed:

Coordinating thread for stitching Black or your choice for applique Machine that has blanket or decorative stitch of your choice option Machine applique foot (if you have one) Sewing machine & basic sewing supplies

You will choose from three (3) gorgeous color options (red, blue, lavender) for your flower, border, and binding preference. You will also choose from two panel fabrics colors, black or white.

#### Skills to Be Taught:

- 1. Creating smooth turned machine appliqué using fusible interfacing.
- 2. Exploring the blanket stitch and other decorative appliqué stitches.
- 3. Fitting your finished center panel into the quilt top.
- 4. Achieving accuracy with seams.
- 5. Adding decorative surprises, i.e., Butterflies!

#### Kit Fee: \$125

\*Fabrics in kits may vary slightly. Kit <u>does not</u> include batting or backing but does include coordinated binding.

### **Basic Supplies Checklist for Class:**

- \_\_\_\_\_1. Scrap piece of fabric 9" x 14" for practice appliqué.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. Sewing machine with manual, power cord and foot pedal.
- 3. Open-toe or appliqué foot if you prefer decorative stitching for appliqué.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. ¼" presser foot with guide.
- 5. Thread To coordinate with fabrics:
  - black or white thread for background panel color
  - your chosen flower petal red, lavender, or blue
  - golden yellow for flower center
  - grassy green for stem and leaves
- 6. Extra loaded bobbins.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. Extension cord or power strip.
- \_\_\_\_ 8. Extra machine needles in different sizes.
- 9. Rotary mat, rotary cutter, extra blades, and rulers.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 10. Sewing tape measure.
- \_\_\_\_\_11. Fabric scissors, thread clippers, seam ripper.
- \_\_\_\_ 12. Straight pins and pin cushion.
- \_\_\_\_\_13. Iron and pressing mat.

**NOTE: Prior to class,** practice decorative stitching with your machine and threads.

## Wish Upon a Star!

This cool project works up so quickly because, as always, Eleanor Burns shows us how to get it done as efficiently as possible. You will receive your complete pattern

in class, (it's included in your class fee), but I've attached some helpful worksheets for your pre-class preparation.

First, there are BLANK DRAWINGS OF OUR QUILT PROJECT. You may make as many copies as you wish to plan your fabric and color placement. You may choose to write descriptions, shade with color, or paste fabric swatches on the drawing to audition your ideas.

Secondly, there is a FABRIC CUTTING CHART taken directly from the pattern. You'll notice there will be slight differences in fabric cutting instructions between the <u>two border options</u>, a *Print Border option* as pictured on the cover of the pattern and a *Scallop Border (Appliqué) option*. I've added a column on the chart for you to track your fabric/color choices.

Then, (one of my favorites), I've included some FABRIC CUTTING LABELS just for you! **Pick the set that matches the border option you've chosen**. While cutting your fabric in preparation for class, pin or clip the labels to each piece. No matter how long in between cutting and sewing time, you won't have to remember all those decisions you've already made! You'll be all organized and ready to sew!

#### Sweet Dreams

#### Fabric requirements:

12 fat quarters

Background: 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yards

Yellow plaid (or accent): 2 1/2 yards for blocks and border

Blue dot: 1 1/3 yards for inner border and binding

Sweet Dreams pattern by Heather Mulder Peterson

#### Cutting:

- From Fat Quarters cut:
  - o 20 6 ½" squares for Step 1
  - $\circ$  20 sets of 4 2 ¼" squares (80 total) for Step 1
  - o 20 sets of 4 2 ¼" x 6 ½" rectangles (80 total) for **Step 1**
  - 12 sets of 4 2 ¼" squares (48 total) for Step 2
  - o 14-21/4" squares for Step 3
- From Background/Cream cut:
  - $\circ$  48 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares and cut each in half once on the diagonal
  - o 4-121/4" squares and cut each in half diagonally twice
  - $\circ~2$  7  $^{5}\!/_{8}$  " squares and cut each in half diagonally once
  - 4-2¼" x WOF strips
    - and subcut into 14 2 ¼" x 9" rectangles
- From Yellow Plaid (or accent) cut:
  - o 11-7¼" x WOF strips
    - Set 8 aside for borders
    - Subcut 3 into: 14 7 ¼" squares
