
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Quilts from El's Kitchen!

INGREDIENTS

1 can (15 oz.) black beans, drained & rinsed 1 can (15 oz.) pinto beans, drained & rinsed 1 cup corn (frozen or canned) 1/2 cup chopped tomato 1/2 cup chopped cilantro 1/3 cup diced orange peppers 1/3 cup diced red peppers 1/3 cup diced yellow peppers 1/3 cup red onions, diced 1 jalapeno, seeded & diced 1 tsp. chili powder 1/2 tsp. ground cumin 1/2 tsp. salt 1/4 tsp. black pepper 3 to 4 Tbsp. olive oil juice of 1 lime tortilla chips for serving

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Mix first 10 ingredients together in a large bowl.
- 2. Add seasonings and mix well.
- 3. Drizzle olive oil.
- 4. Drizzle lime juice.
- 5. Mix well to coat.
- 6. Refrigerate 4 hours or overnight.
- 7. Stir well before serving.

INGREDIENTS

8 oz. cream cheese, softened 1/4 cup heavy cream 3 Tbsp. honey 1 tsp. vanilla extract 2 lb. strawberries 3 bananas

3 Tbsp. fresh lemon juice

- DIRECTIONS
- 1. Rinse strawberries and pat dry. 2. Hull and slice strawberries into large mixing
- 3. Peel and slice bananas and add to
- strawherries 4. Pour lemon juice over fruit and stir until
- mixed and coated in lemon juice. 5. In separate mixing bowl, add softened
- cream cheese, honey, and vanilla extract.
- 6. Using electric mixer, whip until smooth about 3 to 4 minutes.
- 7. Add heavy cream, 1 to 2 tablespoons at a time, whipping until smooth and well combined.
- 8. Continue until all cream is added, being sure to mix well.
- 9. Gently fold the cream cheese mixture into the fruit.
- 10. Chill until ready to serve. 11. ENJOY!


